

Itinerary
Henderson Point / Kerr Lake
Troop 9 Canoe & Camping Trip
20-21 September 2008

Description

The trip is an overnight camp-out on Kerr Lake at the Henderson Point group campsite. The day activities will include swimming, introduction to lake canoeing and kayaking and other Scout skills.

Water Activity and Equipment

Boys and adult leaders with lifesaving skills will be acting as lifeguards and lookouts. Anybody who has not passed a BSA camp swim test must be cleared by the Scoutmaster before swimming. All swimmers will be buddied up. All boys and adults will wear PFDs while in canoes or kayaks. Only boys with BSA swimmer will be allowed in canoes and kayaks. One of the boys in each canoe must have Canoeing merit badge or equivalent training. Boys in kayaks must have Kayaking BSA or an adult supervising. Boys without BSA swimmer may canoe with an adult with canoeing expertise.

Water

- **Nearby Amenities:** Drinking water and restrooms. Henderson Point has portable toilets on site and showers near by in the family campground.

Driving Route

- Estimated travel time is about 1 hour 34 mins.
- From Subway – Timberlyne (1129 Weaver Dairy Rd.)
- Turn left from shopping center onto Weaver Dairy Rd.
- Turn right on to Airport rd/MLK JRr Blvd. /NC-86
- Take ramp on to I-40 E
- Take exit 270 for US-15/US-501 toward Chapel Hill/Durham
- Turn left onto Durham Chapel Hill Blvd./US-15/US-501
- Continue on N. Fordham Blvd./US-15N/US-501N
- Take US-15N/US-501N ramp to Durham/ML King Parkway/I85
- Keep left at fork continuing on US-15N/US-501N to I-85N
- Follow I-85 north to exit 214, NC-39 (Downtown/Henderson)
- Turn left at W. Andrews Ave./NC-39
- Continue on NC-39 for 13.7 miles
- Slight right at Rock Springs Church follow for 3 miles
- Turn right on NC-1359, Rev. Henderson Road
